CALL FOR PAPERS

The *Ateliers de Droit Fiscal* team, under the auspices of the Tax Law Department of the Sorbonne Law School (IRJS, Sorbonne Law School, University of Paris I), is organizing the **Fifth Junior Tax Scholars Conference** and the **First Junior Public Finance Scholars Conference**.

These events will be held at the University of Paris-Sorbonne on **June 19, 2017**, (Pantheon premises, room 1), and will have as their main topic:

The Sources of Tax Law and **The Sources of Public Finance Law**

Under the patronage of Professor Martin Collet

The aim of these conferences is to give to junior tax and public finance scholars, either Ph.D. candidates or doctors having defended a thesis after September 1, 2015, the opportunity to deliver a twenty minutes presentation of their paper.

A Scientific Committee will examine the submitted papers. Those need to be **directly linked to the conferences' topic** and **written in French or English**. The board will heed the originality of the paper's subject together with the methodology adopted.

Junior scholars wishing to participate should apply by **March 30, 2017** (midnight GMT+1), suggesting an idea for a paper. Their paper's project should include a detailed explanation of the paper's content and its structure.

Applicants should enclose their contact information, curriculum vitae, their university affiliation as well as the date of registration in a Ph.D. or of the defense of the thesis. All documents should be sent by e-mail to the Scientific Committee (ateliersdroitfiscal@gmail.com).

The submitted papers are going to be peer-reviewed by the Scientific Committee. Authors of the chosen papers will be contacted by e-mail by the Committee as from **April 15, 2017**.
