The University of Zurich

- Founded in 1833: The University of Zurich was the first university in Europe to be founded by a democratic state – and not by a monarchy or the church
- In 1914: The imposing main building with its landmark tower was inaugurated
- Today: The University of Zurich is Switzerland's largest university with 26'000 enrolled students
- The University of Zurich is a member of the League of European Research Universities and belongs to Europe's most prestigious research institutions
- The University of Zurich consists of 7 faculties, offering a wide variety of Bachelor's, Master's and PhD programs

The Faculty of Law

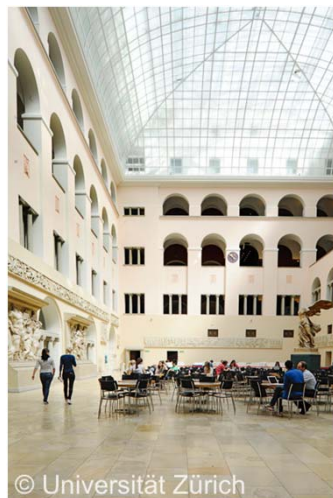
- Founded in 1833: The Law Faculty of the University of Zurich belongs to the largest European law faculties
